- How is my student's iPad connected to the internet whilst at school?
- How is my student protected from unsafe web sites?
- Can my student use cellular (3G/4G) SIM cards in their iPad?





# Internet Connectivity and Security

## Answers

1. Students participating in the iLearn BYO iPad program will be required to access internet resources whilst at school.
2. BYO iPads are only allowed to connect to the school's wireless network when they are on school grounds, using settings provided by the school.
3. Teachers and school staff will assist students in configuring their supported BYO devices connect to the school's Wi-Fi network(s).
4. School content filtering prevents access to sites such as YouTube and internet sites not deemed suitable for students while accessing the school wireless networks.
5. iPads with cellular (3G/4G/5G) connectivity are prohibited from being used whilst on school premises. Devices with cellular connectivity cannot be monitored and cannot be provided with monitored and safe content filtered by the Department of Education. Thus they are not supported under any circumstances.
6. As well as meeting Buzza behaviour expectations, all students using the school's networks will be subject to content filtering. Use of the network is subject to the Department's **Code of School Behaviour**.
